## 1. B - Objectives

To report on the implementation and impact of activities promoting the Transnational Access and Virtual Access services through the JERICO-RI website, social media, news posts and other communication materials and graphics M24 to M54.

## 2. B - Implementation process

The results of the third call and the opening and results of the fourth TA call were promoted through the JERICO-RI website and social media channels. Results of TA projects and activities have been reported and promoted through the JERICO-RI website and social media channels.

A social media campaign with the Hashtag #JERICO\_VA has been implemented to promote JERICO-S3 VA services. News posts promoting the JERICO-S3 VA services have been published on the JERICO-RI website and promoted through established social media channels.

Several communication materials and graphics have been produced to highlight and promote the JERICO-S3 TA and VA activities and distributed through the project communication channels (D10.2) to reach stakeholders.

## 3. B - Main report

This document reports the activities promoting VA and TA services to increase awareness and stakeholder engagement during M24-54. The impact and results of the activities are reported.

### 3.1.Promotion of VA and TA services

The communication team have worked closely with WP8 and WP11 to promote Transnational Access (TA) and Virtual Access (VA) services.

Third TA CAII: The third JERICO-RI S3 Transnational Access (TA) call closed in May 2022. From this call, 12 projects were selected and 10 hosting facilities were utilised. Three project applications included collaborations with other RIs: AQUACOSM and EuroFleets. These RI-RI collaborations were encouraged by JERICO-RI for unique project studies and to create strong networks with other EU RI's. This third call saw 15 group member user nationalities and infrastructures selected for use in 6 hosting countries. In summary, this third call was successful in establishing and strengthening RI-RI collaborations and in facilitating infrastructure access for a diverse user group.

**Fourth TA Call:** The fourth TA call was open from 20th October to 21st November 2022. The call was promoted on the JERICO-RI website

(https://www.jerico-ri.eu/2022/10/20/jerico-s3-4th-call-for-transnational-access-now-open/) and through the established social media channels. 5 new TA projects were accepted after undergoing the reviewing process. This TA call was open for a short time as there was a tight schedule for finalising the call procedures before the end of the year so projects would have an opportunity to start experimental work at the beginning of 2023. This call saw collaborations with users in the Black Sea, Baltic Sea and Eastern Europe.

**TA Results:** A number of dedicated news articles highlighting some of the TA project results were published on the JERICO-RI website and distributed via social media channels. These include:

All social media posts included links to the new articles on the website and all news articles included links to the main <u>TA pages</u>.

**#JERICO\_VA Social Media Campaign and News Articles:** There have been 20 posts on Twitter/X published on the JERICO\_RI account using the <u>#JERICO\_VA</u> hashtag. The posts promote JERICO-S3 VA services and have also been posted on the <u>JERICO-RI Facebook</u> page and <u>LinkedIn\_account</u>.

In addition, 16 news articles promoting specific Virtual Access (VA) services have been published on the JERICO-RI website news page between May 2022 and July 2024. Each article has been further promoted through the #JERICO\_VA social media campaign across Twitter/X, Facebook and LinkedIn during M24-54. Links to the relevant news articles were provided in the #JERICO\_VA social media posts and all news articles included links to the main VA services pages on the project website.

The JERICO RI website Google Analytics tracking was updated from the old service to the new GA4 service in February 2023. The previous data is no longer available. However, Google




Figure 1. Screenshot from Google Analytics showing /virtual-access to be the 7th most viewed path on the JERICO-RI project website, attracting 600 views between February 2023 and July 2024.








Figure 2: Screenshot from Google Analytics showing /news and /ta to be the 11th and 14th most viewed paths on the JERICO-RI project website, attracting 486 and 381 views, respectively between February 2023 and July 2024.

Analytics shows that pages with the /virtual-access root are the 7th most viewed pages between 1st February 2023 and the 30th July 2024 (Figure 1). Whilst /news was the 11th most viewed path and /ta was the 14th over the same period (Figure 2).

This suggests that the combined efforts of the social media campaign, news posts and communication materials reached our stakeholders and resulted in interest in the VA and TA services and information available via the project website.

### Other Communication Materials and Graphics:




Figure 3: JERICO-S3 VA Services Information Poster presented at the JERICO DAYS meeting in June 2022. Downloaded 135 times from the website.








Figure 4: JERICO-S3 TA Services Information Poster presented at the JERICO DAYS meeting in June 2022. Downloaded 119 times from the website.








Figure 5: JERICO-S3 VA Services and JERICO-CORE Information Poster presented at the JERICO DAYS meeting in June 2022. Downloaded 151 times from the website.

A series of posters were designed and produced for JERICO-DAYS 2022 that took place from 28th – 30th June 2022 at the Hydrographic Institute, Lisbon. Three of the 10 information posters were designed to promote the JERICO-S3 TA and VA services. All of the <u>posters</u> are available for re-use on the JERICO-RI website. They were also promoted on Social Media during and after the event (Figures 3, 4, 5). The 3 posters have been downloaded a total of 405 times from the project website (Source: jerico-ri.eu cms statistics, accessed July 2024).

### 4. B - Conclusion

### 4.1. Synthesis of the main conclusions

The results of the third TA call were published on the project website. The opening of the fourth TA call was prompted on the project website and social media channels. The results of the fourth call were published on the project website.

A number of dedicated news articles highlighting some of the TA project results were produced and published on the project website. These were also promoted via social media channels and linked to the project website news posts.

A social media campaign using the hashtag #JERICO\_VA was implemented across the JERICO-RI Twitter/X, Facebook and LinkedIn social media channels. 16 dedicated news posts highlighting JERICO-S3 VA services were produced and published on the JERICO-RI project website. The news posts were promoted as part of the VA social media campaign and linked to the website.

Website traffic shows that /virtual-access, /news, and /ta were the 7th, 11th and 14th most viewed paths, respectively suggesting that the social media activities, news posts and other communication materials engaged with stakeholders and attracted traffic to the relevant sections on the website.

Three of the 10 information posters produced for the JERICO-Days event in June 2022 were dedicated to promoting TA and VA services. They are available on the project website and have been downloaded a total of 405 times.
